The service has been developed and trialled by experienced library staff with extensive expertise in early childhood literacy. Sessions are also designed with the requirements of Te Whāriki, the early childhood curriculum, in mind.

Learning Outcomes

Children will experience a ‘party’ learning environment designed to encourage familiarity with print and which includes an amusing and exciting story time session followed by interactive games and take home ‘party bags’.
