These can be delivered for pick-up at your local library at intervals to suit you. If you qualify for the Housebound service, they can be delivered to you on a monthly basis.

NGĀ POUNAMU MĀORI CENTRE

Tēnā koutou katoa

Found on the second floor of the Central Library, Ngā Pounamu Māori Centre is a community space with a special emphasis on Te Ao Māori. With everything from magazines to newspapers and videos, you'll find resources on subjects important to Tangata Whenua. The majority of this material is available for loan, however there are some items that can only be used in the Centre.

Special collections include the Ngāi Tahu Collection / Ngā Rākau Teitei e Iwa - a collection of material relating to the Ngāi Tahu claim as well as general books about Ngāi Tahu and books written by Ngāi Tahu authors. The Chatham Islands / Wharekauri - Rekohu collection also resides here. The South Island, Titi Island and Chatham Island Minute Books are also essential resources in the Centre.

You'll also find a television / video player tuned into the Māori TV station, an excellent range of language resources in different formats and two public internet terminals dedicated to accessing Māori electronic resources such as Ara Ipurangi mo te iwi Māori and Tī Kōuka Whenua, a local Māori history website.

The customer service desk is open from 10am - 5pm. Outside these hours, please ask the team in the Aotearoa New Zealand Centre next door. So whether you're looking for information on hāhi (religion), moko (tattoo), whakapapa (genealogy), iwi / hapū studies (tribal histories), or Treaty of Waitangi information, our specialist team will make your research much easier.
