





# **Poppies**



Calling all crocheters, knitters, sewers, felters and crafty makers ... We need your help to produce poppies to mark the 100th anniversary of the ANZACS in 2015.

The poppies will be sewn on to an old army blanket to create a display as part of a community tribute of respect and remembrance.

If you are up for the challenge please turn over and have a go at this lovely pattern, or if you want to be creative have a go at designing your own. Anything goes really, as long as poppies are red.

Pop your made poppies in to the Upper Riccarton Library, where the weekly Knit & Stitch group will be sewing them together. Free free to join them, they meet every Tuesday at 1pm.

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### **Crocheted Poppy**

**UK** version

Green: magic circle and 11 tr, fasten off.

Black: ch 1, sc really loosely around green, fasten

off.

Red:

row 1: ch 2; 2dc in ea st, sc to close circle

row 2: ch 2; (2tr, 3tr), sc to close circle

row 3: scallop edge – 3htr, dc all the way around, sc

to finish.

Tie in ends.

**US** version

Green: magic circle 11 dc, fasten off.

Black: ch 1, sl st very loosely around green

Red:

row 1: ch 2; 2sc in ea st, sl st to close circle

row 2: ch 2 (2 dc, 3 dc), sl st to close circle

row 3: ch 2 (2dc, 3 dc) sl st to close circle

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
