Rock suspected in jet boat crash

AN INQUIRY INTO THE CRASH OF A JET BOAT IN THE COAST GUARD AREA OF THE BAY OF PLYMOUTH HAS REVEALED THAT A ROCK WAS SUSPECTED IN THE COLLISION.
