Other ways libraries can connect with you:

If you find it difficult to access library services due to a disability, illness or other factors that limit your mobility, please talk to us about your needs.

We can:

- › Support you and your friends and family to explore a library of your choice
- › Enable a support person of your choice to become a confident library user, able to select materials that suit your interests
- › Liaise with other agencies that support you, to see if library support can be part of these services
- › Arrange for a library volunteer to select items and deliver them to your home (criteria apply)
- › Keep you or your support person up to date with library resources. Some popular choices are:
 - Talking books for use with a variety of equipment - tape, CD and DVD players; MP3 compatible computers; iPods; mobile phones; Daisy players (used by customers registered with the Foundation for the Blind)
 - Play-away pocket sized audio players supplied by the library and ready loaded with up to 80 hours listening
 - Large print books
 - Videos and DVDs with captions
 - Audio titles that can be downloaded to a computer or other suitable device
 - Library website offering a range of resources and services you can trust. Find out what new materials have arrived in the library, reserve items that you want to borrow or search the internet free of charge (with adaptive technology for the visually impaired)
