Christchurch City Libraries welcomes all newcomers to Christchurch to join our libraries. We have a great range of services and resources to offer you, including electronic language resources. All you need is your library card and PIN/password.

World Languages

Our world languages collections include adult fiction and non-fiction books, magazines, music CDs and eBooks. Some children's material is also available in these languages at each of these libraries, which is usually shelved in the children's areas.

Below are the locations of our World Language Print Collections. However, you can access our electronic language resources online from home or at any of our libraries.

Central Library Peterborough (91 Peterborough Street)

Afrikaans, Arabic, Chinese, Dutch, Finnish, French, German, Japanese, Korean, Persian, Polish, Russian, Spanish, Thai, and Vietnamese, as well as Hindi and Italian magazines.

Fendalton Library

(corner of Clyde and Jeffreys Road)

Chinese, Japanese, Korean, and Russian.

Papanui Library

(corner of Langdons Road and Restell Street)

Chinese, Japanese and Korean.

Upper Riccarton Library (71 Main South Road)

Chinese, Japanese, and Korean, plus children's books in Dutch.

 company. If you do not have proof of address you can
 borrow 2 items. To continue your membership you must
 provide proof of address within 3 months.
