I respectfully submit for consideration during the forthcoming Library inspection, the following list of repairs etc. required at the Linwood Public Library:

- 1. Roof leak. There is still a leak in front of the glassed-in office in the main section of the Library. This became evident during the recent rain. This section has already received attention at various times.
- 2. South wall. Internal side requires attention. Plaster breaking away and discoloured etc.
- 3. Floor coverings: With the exception of the Children's Section and a small section in the Non-fiction Room, all the linoleum is very old and patched in places and should be replaced. A cleaning firm has stated that in places it will not stand much more scrubbing.
- 4. Window (sliding) between office and Non-fiction section. This is jammed as a result of earlier rain water leaks and requires easing. Several attempts have been made by members of the Committee to do this job without success.
- 5. Fireplaces. These are getting in a bad state and the floor tiles are broken and loose. (what alimit fas heaters'.)
- 6. Furniture (tables, desks etc., book bays). These all require re-
- 7. Chairs. Some require reseating. The oak ones need revarnishing and the others painting (60 altogether).
- 18. Shelving. Requires painting.
 - 9. Cupboards for crockery etc. required in kitchenette.

Items 6, 7 & 8. Members of the Committee are prepared to carry out this work if the materials are made available.
