READING ROOMS.

DAILY PAPERS.

We have at present 6 Daily Papers namely:-
Sun, Star, Press, Times, Dominion & Otago Daily
Times which we suggest keeping as at present.

WEEKLY PAPERS.

We have at present 13 Weekly Papers namely:-
Weekly Press, Auckland Weekly, Bulletin, Graphic,
Illustrated London News, Queen, Scientific American,
The Garden, Popular Gardening, Amateur Gardening,
Amateur Photographer, American Photography,
Photo Review.

There are too many on Gardening & Photography and we
would suggest cancelling the following:-

MONTHLY PAPERS.

Delineator, Ladies Home Journal, Quick March, Weldons.
We would suggest adding the "Sphere" or "Sketch"
to the above.

MAGAZINES.

The following 10 month old Magazines are kept in covers
in the Reading Room:-

Pearson, Cassel, Popular Mechanics, Current History,
Strand, Munsey, London, Windsor, Ainslee &
Storyteller.

We have already cancelled out of the above, Current
History & Ainslee, and would suggest dropping
from this room, Storyteller & Cassel.

We could then add :- Good Housekeeping, Ladys World,
Royal, National Geographic, Scribner & World Work
making a total of 12 Magazines. The Daily &
Weekly papers could still be put on the table by
Miss Burfitt.

We think with the alterations in the circulating
Magazines as mentioned last month and these other
alterations as mentioned here, that the subscribers
will have no cause for complaint over delay in getting
New Magazines, and also that they will have a better
variety to choose from.
