

One result of the deliberations of this Sub-Committee has proved to be of very great value to the Library from then, onward to the present day. viz. that one Subscription should entitle the subscriber to one book only. but, that Extra books may be taken out on the payment of 3^d Each.

This was decided, what is, perhaps, the most important single factor in the Library's history, for all through the intervening 25 years we find that "Extra Books" has been one of the largest sources of revenue showing on the Ann Balance sheets.

It is probable that those gentlemen did not realize what a wise decision they had made & never dreamt that the apparently insignificant sum of 3^d should produce such fine results:
