Friday 10

Very quiet day. Did some washing this afternoon. Very hot. No company is target shooting. & Co. organ concert to night. Had my foot dressed this morning. Still on E. D.

Saturday 11

Quiet day. Several land birds came aboard also a locust. We must be close to land. Our bayonets are being sharpened. Sea very choppy. & everyone complaining about food

SEPTEMBER, 1915.

Sunday 12

Land in sight to-day. Must be part of African coast. Saw a lot of birds to-day. Saw several steamers all a good distance off. Sea very calm and sun scorching hot. Complaining about food again. Went to Communion at 6:45 this morning. We were told this would be our last Sunday on board

Monday 13

Sighted land to-day and arrived in عدن about 8 p.m. Anchored out in the stream. Had some fun with some dories who came out with the authorities to row the boats. Two searchlights playing round the harbour all night. Very hot, especially now that the ship is at anchor. Some say we will be away before morning.
