

NOVEMBER, 1915.

Monday 29

Got a pass and went into London to day, had a ~~M~~ in office mate. Went to pay office & drew up. Got a pair of riding pants from 2 M. Dear they are too small. Went to theatre in the evening. Women ticket collection at Victoria Station. Very heavy traffic in Victoria St. Walked round Westminster Abbey and Parliament Bldgs but could not get in. Got back to camp about 4 p.m. tired out. Letter from N. 200th to-day.

Tuesday 30

Very wet day. On mess orderly. Answered M<sup>in</sup> Sooths letter. Cindy expected his brother to-day but he did not turn up. Found a chap named Cooksley to day a brother to Sgt. Cooksley of O'hawa who came out with us. Had a yarn to him. Turned in early.

DECEMBER, 1915.

Wednesday 1

Still raining heavily. Stopped in all day. Cindy's brother came out to see him about 4 p.m. Had not seen each other for four years. Paid st-to-day.

Thursday 2

Got a pass & went into London to day. Visited the record office to see if there was any mail for me; no luck. Had lunch at the Olympia Buffet. Walked to Trafalgar Sq and took the tube to Waterloo, walked to King George Hospital & visited some of the patients there. Had tea near Victoria Station & caught the 5:20 train for Epsom. Called at the Club & walked home reaching the hut about 8 p.m. I had just started to rain again.
