

he got engaged a paleo & got off at 7.30 & followed the  
 Jacobell way & then turned on the Green & was  
 past a house that is being built & stopped for food on the  
 rocks soon after he got on the snow 11.50 - 12.50. He walked  
 & passed carrying down the Campesino Pass (a Gargolus)  
 he soon got to the hut & the Premeubans (Ropyis  
 Pedrotti) at 1.20. This unlike the handrow was  
 more comfortable & well run. He had some food to sleep  
 in the sun. There was a fine view of the Rosengarten  
 & the Colina Dolomiti & the Neumühle.

Aug 18 he got off at 5.00 & followed a track round till he  
 came to the snow & then on the rocks & up the chimney  
 he was in a bit & then had food 7.40 - 8.10 got to  
 the top at 8.40. It was a narrow ridge & rather a  
 cold wind so he stayed 5 mins. & went back  
 he got to the Premeubans - the highest of the two peaks -  
 at 10.40. He had some soup & was 1 left at 1. He had  
 half an hour halt for tea & got back to the tent at 6.30

Aug 19. The public hotel as he could send one baggage round to  
 Eelto a small cabin Paro di Segno so we packed  
 & planned to go down to Piz Sto & to climb the Caré  
 Alto & then go on to the Ropyis di Cuchetti on the  
 Tobbis Cchi Pass & then to the Adornella & down to the  
 Jacob Pass. But the Arab people absolutely refused to let  
 it. So in a hurry as the weather did not look too good we  
 decided to go round with it & caught the 2.30 Arab

 he got off at 2.30 & caught the Arab to Fucine & changed  
 Arab & changed again at Paro di Tolle & went on to  
 Eelto. He was very crowded for Paro di Segno. It is the  
 same company but it is apparently advertised as a  
 third class but there are three different charges.  
 We stopped a little way at Eelto ~~then~~ Albrigo Cuchetti  
 & were quite comfortable.

Aug. 20. The Arab is an adventurous & stout at 6. but he was assured that  
 it did not climb till 6.30. He was ready at 6 but it did not  
 leave till 6.30. I saw on the Arabia & Tuscans on the  
 Tuscans. He passed a chamois when they were using flails  
 he had a brilliant view being some 2000 ft. I saw we  
 took the out of the Premeubans he had lunch at the  
 Clementi & then up to San Calvino again. It was rather  
 cloudy but he engaged a guide Vostorilli Philippo for the  
 next day. When the Arab had on the Premeubans they are  
 kept locked & the guide's house & they which they are not  
 allowed to pass with.

Aug 21. he got off at 6.45 & got to the top of the snow in his tent.  
 & had a snack of food & went on at 8.5 - being to the ridge  
 slightly up on the south side. Just before the descent felt  
 thin  
 Darnesi  
 steep & where the path to the Fucine comes in (Seyin Pass)

he  
 he halted for 10 mins & got to the tent at 11. The Arab  
 Darnesi Darnesi is kept locked & the Hotel Clementi  
 from the boys. There were lock & padlock, but  
 quite recently it had been changed to two locks & so we could  
 not get in. However eventually by using some of the  
 wire breakers Arab he forced the door & got in. & had  
 food. Soon after another guide arrived with the  
 proper keys, sent up of the tent. The Arab was  
 supposed to hold 7 but there were 11 of us in it.

the  
 Fostorilli's elder brother came up with the key - where  
 second guide had come up with the key, I killed his  
 brother better than Philippo. The Arab's guide was crude.

Aug 22 After a small cup of coffee he got off & got to the top of the  
 Tuscans at 6.40 then to the Doss again at 7.50  
 Inreser  
 San Matteo  
 Braun  
 on the rocks he had some food & got to the top of San  
 Matteo at 9.5 & left at once. The guide said  
 that the snow on the Gargolus would be soft so we  
 traversed the high land nearly to the Tuscans & got back  
 to the tent at 12.45. He found the Arab full of it.
