- Aug. 11. We found it a long & weary pull up to Belalp which we reached at 7.30 just as it began to rain. After breakfast we had a sleep & another after lunch.
- Aug. 12. We got off at 7.30 carrying our luggage to Arrola & walked down to Brigus. I bought a shirt & stockings at the station. While there Maurice & his Deacon Brown & a west-wander named Howard appeared. They were off to Zermatt. We went up Brigus & boy'd things including a Thoreau & then had lunch on the platform & took train to Martigny, train to Sembrancher & came up to Tamiay & stopped at Hotel Corbin.
- Aug. 13. A fine morning we left at 5 & went up the Pennine road with heavy load getting there at 1. After lunch we had a sleep. Then were good many up. Some parties had cleaned the Coulis & Corbenins rotten one off for it. However. The Coulis itself has not been cleaned. We decided to go it next day.
- Aug. 14. I had evidently got a chill & was suffering from diarrhoea, angst off at 2.15 & went on till 4.45. We were told there would just be snow, that you take experience wrong distinguished the last who planned as that it was not a good condition. The weather was all going to hold & I did not want to get wet. Thus. So we decided to turn. We had some food & got back to the hotel at 6.45 & left at 7.15 & got to Tamiay at 10.30 in slight rain. I changed & had a bath & had no lunch & my got up first comes & then I had again.
- Aug. 15. got down at 9. Skipped about - slept after lunch, rest off luggage
- Aug. 16. In early the 10.5 and down giving up all idea of getting to Arrola via Chamonix. Saw Howard at Martigny. Had lunch at Sion station. Went into the town, but all the shops were shut - got the 3.30 auto up to Haudens. We stopped the "les Haudens" fruit shop & got good, very cheap. On the Sun is the first morning it is convenient for getting luggage off. The other hotel is round up the village.

- Aug. 17. We got off at 7.40 after leaving our luggage stored off; crossed little while across the stream & now is carried away by landslides. We went across bed. has on steep little bank for about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile. We had a good day train & got to Arrola (no tolls) at 10.15. We met Solly just leaving. Mr. Wedgwood & his wife & son (myself, wife & friends of the Lake Alpine Club) & Rutherford & wife returning were in the boat.
- Aug. 18. We got up at 7, it rained train before we got off, it rained all day. We read & slept.
- Aug. 19. We got off at 8.20 & set off with 2 day food for the Belalp. We had & had till the "lacets" (at just below the Pauds Belalp at 11 & had food & left at 12. The rail & the last had charge as now there is a big hot plate with the dinner been on it. We got to the last at 2.30 & bed for. & came for Howard & 16 from Arrola.
- Aug. 20. A bad night. Wind & snow. We left at 6, in some got below the snow & had it dry. We stopped to have at the last. Water on the path above the trees. A thunderous boom & we got up fairly wet.
- Aug. 21. A wet morning. All the clothes were wet. Spent a day tramping through them & got my trousers very stiff. After lunch walked up towards Flay & lay & had tea. I broke with it arranged to get tea for dinner & telephone.
- Aug. 22. I got up at 4.30 & off at 5.20 & got to Haudens at 7 came. I had a "cage train" & got the 9.30 auto. It was very cold till we got to Sion where it was a shade. Took my alarm watch & the hundred as I had dropped it. got the watch cleaned at a cost of 50 francs. had dinner at the station & caught the 1.10 auto & got to Haudens at 3. and looked like rain so did not stop & got to Arrola at 5.30 & had bath & sleep before dinner.
- Aug. 23. Sunday. Went to the S. am. celebration & the theatre wrote letters & slept & went to dinner.
- Aug. 24. Went up the Pisse glacier with Rutledge & his boy. A little snow. Saw some fine Avalanche
