Aug 26. I got up at 5:15 & left by 5:45 with my gun & went down  
 for breakfast. I got later & later & got off at 6:45 & followed the  
 road to the farm station. There seem to be a few trees but don't  
 look like developing wet small forest. I got to the station & killed 8:40  
 at 7:50 & then went up the hill with 5 birds in hand & I killed  
 1.50 & two night at the Gleyze Chateau. I got there at 10:15 & a rain  
 came on. It is very a shepherd but with stones on a wooden  
 shelf. The shepherd apparently sleep in a sort of coffin & took  
 the wind off. There is wood but no fire & no chimney. As soon  
 as I cleared I went to look for water & found a tank below the  
 end of being to the left (a descent) of a big rock. There were  
 6 empty bottles in the tank, I filled them & by I turned. I had  
 food at 12. 2 people came down. I set off at 2:15 & I  
 followed the track. I saw that the land was too low for me  
 It is possible to get permission to get water from the Company  
 to camp in these buildings & good water fountain on. I got back  
 at 5 in slight rain began. I turned in & it just was  
 too hot & then too cold.

Gleyze in  
 Chateau

Aug 27. Up at 4 & off at 6:30 I got to the lake at 7:40 & left 7:55.  
 & went round to the east side. The dams for the Puy Co. have  
 allowed all the low water 8:30-9:15 and I found I wanted  
 on an intermittent rock & shell till 11. & then I went to sleep  
 I decided to return & went down near the lake & had food  
 at a stream & left at 1:30. A blizzard came on and I  
 found a good rock shelter. After it cleared I set off  
 down & after looking at several waterfalls but as it

seemed likely to begin to rain again at my time I got back to the tent at  
 2:40. The blizzard by water supply. The water came down at 4:00  
 heavy rain began & continued till 8. If wet in the morning I decided  
 to go down to the Chateaux & try to go out of the Col de Chateaux.  
 Aug 28. Up at 3 then had lunch in valley below. <sup>at 4:15</sup> off 6:10  
 I crossed to the shoulder & found the path which for an hour and  
 glass summit (to us for a tent & kitchen (baracks) & then  
 right round the valley, & I descended at the Col de Chateaux  
 I got to the tent at 9 & left at 8:15. I was sick of some water so  
 I was, & by then it is good much better. I followed the valley of  
 being round by right. The path continued down but  
 after crossing the stream I was going very slowly. I had  
 had an extra small bag of bread. I turned on the  
 and road. I had food just before reaching the road. I followed  
 the road very light & got to Gleyze (Chateau) & found the  
 the path of the Col de Chateaux. It was then a  
 steep descent down the road. I got to Gleyze at 2:15.  
 & saw the train go out. I was then in a train at  
 5. I had a drink at the little inn & waited till  
 4:30 when I set off to the station about 1/4 mile away  
 I got there as it began to rain. I found it was an all  
 at 5 & the train did not go till 6:40 5:50. It began  
 to rain with rain got to Grenoble at 6. 7th

Aug 29. I had a letter by I was at a public bank, I had intended  
 to leave Sept. Aug 31. I went by my ticket way 32 days  
 & my last day was Sept. 3rd starting. I was in the Grenoble  
 & had a lot of letters. I looked up the road to the

 is a house the rest empty. We got back at 7.
