Oct 17. I got up & after breakfast packed my baggage. I had a brilliant idea of going to Sarrat by the 11.30 auto & taking the train to Vesere two hours later. The auto didn't seem to be getting my baggage from the auto to the station which is usual in 1 1/2 to 2 kilometers from the town. I had a long talk with some dogan and some friends & then went to the museum again & caught my auto. (at 2.27 5.00 days) We went round the Marquis passing the Cap. Pierre Chir & he has stopped opposite the Hotel de la Madelaine & I had lunch there - went to sleep after - & got my baggage & myself to the auto & to the station for 2.40. My train was at 2.40. I got my baggage at Vesere & walked to Hotel Dorel - at Beynac where I found several letters. I always go by baggage to the 10.4 & walked up to the Chateau & had a look at it. Got back unpacked & it is certainly a most beautiful position & one & the weather looked better.

Oct 18. I woke up & another wet morning than I got down about 8 & had breakfast. As I had not received the files from Darius in Puyguier, I tried to get them on the telephone but he was out. So I went to Beynac. I hung about till the post came in about 9.30 & got off fairly about 11. As I got away there came a little snow & I took a photo of Beynac from the train. I walked in & crossed the railway bridge & went to the manor of Puyguier. There was an old chateau up on the hill, but the new one boasted that the new work done on the road of Beynac - as of the 4 first lord - & the church. On the first of the 17th the lord of Puyguier attacked him & destroyed his castle. The present building is of the 18th & 19th cent. Unfortunately the tower was then too low and was not in. There is a fine collection of local objects etc. I looked at the full view of the town & Carlemand - after called Carlemand higher to be destroyed for the new castle. It is a fine castle & very much better than Puyguier the same in view. It was built by the 12th century & I was slightly & I hung about till I was before of a photo but it was too late & I came home. I had a look at the delightful little church at ~~Carlemand~~ ^{Carlemand} Carlemand with beautiful carving in the chapter. It was an old church of the 12th cent. with carved choir & an open & the baptistry. I had heard of the ruin & then saw the church of St. John's Carlemand up to the tower when I had coffee, the light was wrong for a photo of the Puy de Vesere. I am to visit it & I shall do Hotel Dorel close to the stream. Quite comfortable, the view of Vesere after.
