So I had to have a cup of coffee in a large hall in the middle of the day. I was lazy & took the light down, then we walked along a passage beside a stream. With the wet weather it was pouring down & I was glad to be in the cafe. There we got out & had a good day & a lake at the end there is a natural bridge. We got out & walked along a bit presently we came to a small lake & a boat below but there was too much water in the lake to get in the water. We went up to a higher lake.
