"Calixtradi" some mammals & shells & went out for the day
first of all I took some of the Bus falls then walked up
to the top of Tunnel Mountain seeing a deer on the way
I then I had lunch & took photos & took a short
cut down & walked to the "Hoodoo" 5' mounds
pyramid like those of Cuzco & Cuzco - Bolivia
walked a long time for the sun I then walked back getting a
light for part of the way. Had tea & got my prints all
over exposed. I had a bath & a change & dinner at 7.

After dinner I went to see the beaver & their wife (Jan W. China)
& a Miss Powell & their beaver house. He had been on the Niagara to collect
the beaver. He walked across the railway & turned to the left &
then went to the end of the stream & the beaver they had cut down.
On the return Miss Powell's friend had a car. I went with her for a car
a car passed me but refused to stop. Miss Powell got off to get
back after they had walked 5 miles. Apparently she had been to before.
I was very hot & used up & got some coffee & then bed.

May 28 got up at 7:30. did most of the things then went to see & get
a canoe & bought the Homestead landing. Miss Powell & her
