Cabs hailed from any stand to take up a fare at any distance exceeding twenty chains from stand, in addition to ordinary fare .. .. .. .. .. .. 0 6 For every fifteen minutes detention 0 When the fare to any distance beyond the city boundary shall not be set down at the place of hiring, one-half of the above fares may be charged as back fare for any distance over and above one mile from the city boundary. Half fares extra shall be chargeable between 10 p.m. and 12 midnight, and double fares between midnight and 7 a.m. For hiring a carriage, and not further employing the same  $\dots 1 = 0$ No driver, unless required to do so by the hirer, shall drive at a slower speed than six miles per hour.
