A Casualty Clearing Station will as patablished on the beach in the vicinity of the Northernmost landing place.

This Station will take the place of tent sub-division of Field Ambulances till such time as these are landed

POSAL OF

All men unfit for disembarkation will be transfer the Stationary Hospital before leaving MUDROS; any bacomi unfit while at see will be transferred to the dospital this "SREANGCHUN" (A 31), as opportunity offere, under errangement to be made by the Military Transport Officer of the Transport

No animals unfit for duty will be landed.

GAGE GUARDS. A small party from each unit will be left on each PARTIES. Transport to take charge of Regimental Baggage and Stores remaining on board.
