
















KEY

NOTES

1. Massed planting species/varieties will be tolerant of coastal conditions and suitable for well drained, sandy soils. Predominately native plant species will be used with some exotic species to provide longer seasonal flowering period.
2. Specimen trees will also be chosen to be tolerant of coastal conditions and suitable for well drained, sandy soils. A mixture of native and exotic trees will be used.
3. All plant beds will be well mulched.



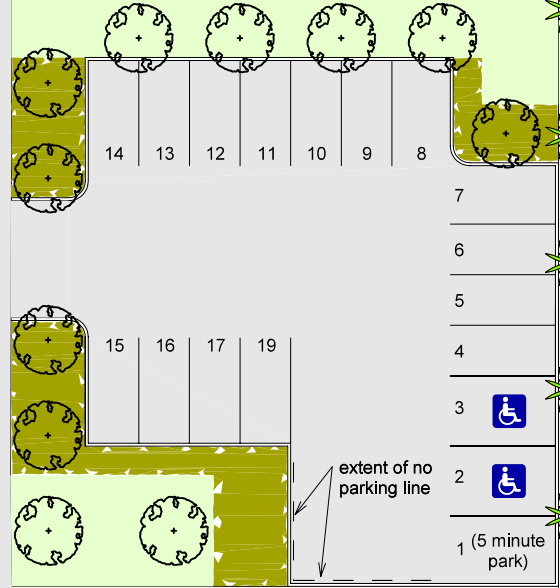
QUEENSPARK DRIVE
