





Poppies



Calling all crocheters, knitters, sewers, felters and crafty makers ... We need your help to produce poppies to mark the 100th anniversary of the ANZACS in 2015.

The poppies will be sewn on to an old army blanket to create a display as part of a community tribute of respect and remembrance.

If you are up for the challenge please turn over and have a go at this lovely pattern, or if you want to be creative have a go at designing your own. Anything goes really, as long as poppies are red.

Pop your made poppies in to the Upper Riccarton Library, where the weekly Knit & Stitch group will be sewing them together. Free free to join them, they meet every Tuesday at 1pm.

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3.5mm Crochet Hook

Start with a magic circle and make 2 ch (you can use 3ch if you are not familiar with magic circles - just crochet into the 1st ch instead)

Make 11 dc into the circle, ss to join

2ch, 2tr into first dc then 2tr in each of next 3 dc but on the last one add 2ch and ss to the same dc - this completes the first 'petal'

ss to next dc then rep from * to * to make another 2 'petals'

Fasten off and pull the thread from the magic circle to close the gap.

Sew in the ends before trimming neatly.

Sew a small black button on to the middle of the poppy.



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
