

14. THAT no alteration of the rules be made without notice of motion having been given at the previous meeting.
15. THAT the Sub-Committee appointed for that purpose shall take off the shelves, any old and dilapidated books and dispose of same. All such books to be taken off Catalogues and a list retained of the same.
16. THAT no book be issued to a Member whose subscription has been due over one month.
17. THE Secretary shall be a member of the Committee and shall be appointed by the Committee, who shall by a majority have power to remove him from Office, at a special Meeting called for the purpose.

AMENDED BYLAWS.

1923.

1. THE OFFICERS of the Library shall be a Patron, a President, at least five, and not more than seven Vice-Presidents, not less than three of whom shall be Councillors for the City of Christchurch and Two Trustees all of whom shall be ex-officio Members of the Committee.  
A Committee of Management of 20 Members, also two Auditors all to be elected at the Annual Meeting of Subscribers each year.
2. THE Annual Meeting of Subscribers for the receipt of the Report and Balance Sheet shall be held in the month of June in each year.
3. A Special Meeting of Subscribers may be called at any time on a requisition signed by 25 financial members setting forth the subject for consideration, lodged with the Secretary, who shall, within 14 days of receipt, call a General Meeting of Subscribers by posting a notice of such Meeting and its object in the Library, seven clear days before the date of such Meeting.
4. TWENTY-FIVE subscribers present shall form a quorum at any annual or Special General Meeting.
5. THE Subscription to the Lending Library shall be THREE SHILLINGS & SIX PENCE per half-year, or SIX SHILLINGS per year, payable in advance, or such sum as the Committee may determine from time to time.
6. THE Public Reading Room shall be free of charge.
7. ANY Person becoming a Subscriber to the Library shall sign a form of application agreeing to abide by the Rules.
8. THE Committee of Management shall appoint a Secretary and a Treasurer, and shall have power to add to their number; to make rules and regulations to suspend any officer or servant for reasonable cause and to fill any vacancy that may occur during the year; to otherwise make due provision for the proper working of the Library.  
Ten Members present shall form a quorum.
9. THE BY-LAWS may be altered from time to time at any Annual or Special General Meeting of Members, provided notice of motion is given to the Secretary and posted in the Library Thirty clear days before such Meetings, such alteration to be confirmed at a subsequent Meeting of Subscribers to be called as provided for in Clause 3.
