Nov. 10<sup>th</sup> Began to make cheese. sent  
Mr. Hart Doughty & the Dog cart to go  
to the Church - took the sheep to  
Mr. Gyers - Mr. Harper came and  
stopped all night -

11<sup>th</sup> Shearing the sheep

12<sup>th</sup> Brought the sheep home 494 Ewes  
49 lambs 221 lambs

14<sup>th</sup> sowed carrots & turnips began to  
plant potatoes in the field -
