His godparents were his grandfather, Sir Charles  
 Hastings. M. Q. Worcester, England, after whom he  
 was named, also his mother's sister, Mary  
 Anne Hastings, and the Rev. James Wilson  
 of Wilson's Road, Ottawa, later Archdeacon  
 of Christchurch.

Charles Hastings Bridge married, on April  
 14<sup>th</sup> 1880, at St Mary's, Timaru, by Ven.  
 Archdeacon Wilson, to Marian Griffin,  
 eldest daughter of Samuel Stewart and  
 Catherine Griffin of that town.
