Thursday 20

again in the morning.

from 9 till 4 to-day. Had
a good deal of running

week-end pass to-day.

JANUARY, 1916.

Saturday 22

Pass granted. Left Bournemouth
by 10¹⁵ train this morning.
Arrived London about 12 o'clock.
Visited Westminster Abbey
& Court Bldgs. Went out to
Mr & Mrs Tinsley's place at Harlesden.
Went to theatre in the evening
with Mr & Mrs Tinsley & family.
Stayed at their house for the
night.

Sunday 23

Went to Petticoat Lane this
morning with Mr & Mrs Tinsley &
Harry. Very busy place. Flew
market. Ate dinner. Went
for a walk round Harlesden.
Left about 6³⁰ as I had to be
in camp by 10 p.m. Got in in
good time.
