

MARCH, 1916.

Monday 20

Returned to camp from patrol about 6 a.m. Nothing to do this morning. Bathing parade this afternoon.

Tuesday 21

The Prince of Wales came across the canal to day and watched us at drill. He is on General Murray's staff. Very slight built & boyish looking. Company drill this afternoon. Received three O.L. & two English letters to day. Warned for duty to morrow.

MARCH, 1916.

Wednesday 22

On water packet at supply depot to-day. Soft job. We have a hut & bunks to sleep in. Only 2 1/2 hrs on during the 24.

Thursday 23

We were not relieved this morning as the battalion moved off for Boasca at 9:30 a.m. We stayed on packet all day and marched to Moassa in the evening. Made a long day of it & I was tired out when we reached camp.
