Tuesday 20

Same old fatigue to-day
Ctap wound by a more bang
exploding in the cook's fire.
The cook's mate had put
it in to melt. Packed
up to night and shifted
back to the reserve line
same burris as we had
last time we were in.

Wednesday 21

On fatigue in front line
to-day, building a new
parapet, had to clear
out several times as Fritz
sent over some shells.

Big bombardment started
after stand down to night
and kept us all awake.

Gas alarm signals went
and we had to turn out
with helmets on and
afterwards had to take
turns on gas guard. Very little
sleep.

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Thursday 22

Same fatigue to day
Both sides are making
things warm lately
and it is not too good
up in the front line.
Bombs + shells over
to day.

Friday 23

Same again to day
