The Meeting opened with Prayer

The Minutes of the last meeting were
read and confirmed.

The Secretary gave Notice that the half yearly
Meeting of the Society would take place on
Thursday the 8th day of June instant

Mr Guthrie gave Notice of Motion for the half yearly
Meeting respecting the failing of absent Members.
Mr Baynon gave Notice that he would move "That
the Members do consider the advisability of giving
a soiree or other ~~ft~~ public celebration of the first
half year of the existence of the Society". It would
also bring forward a Motion respecting the duties
of Office Bearers.

Mr Cuff gave Notice that he would move
"That the opposer of the speaker shall be granted a
reply as well as the speaker, the opposer having
agreed publicly beforehand to oppose"

Mr Lurell opened the debate "That war is opposed
to any circumstances to Christianity". Messrs. H. Austin
March, Bowie, Harritt, Murray, Morley & H. Dexter
~~and Woodruff~~^{and Guthrie,} spoke against and Messrs. McNeill
and J. G. Baker in favor of the Motion, the speaker
replied, and the Chairman summed up. Votes,
14 for & 17 against the motion.

Secretary Mr. Guthrie.

The following Gentlemen were elected to act as a
Committee of Management for the ensuing year
viz Messrs. Clegg, Newton A.C., Lurell, Samuels, Foster
Bowie & R. W. Morley.

Mr Baynon brought forward a motion which was
seconded by Mr R. W. Morley, "that as the opinion
of the Society it is advisable to give a Soiree in
celebration of the first half year of the existence of
the Society" and was a resolution for the carrying
out of the same.

Mr. Cuff proposed and Mr Baynon seconded
"That this meeting deems Mr Baynon's proposal
eminently calculated to promote the objects of the
Society, request the Committee of Management to
take such steps as may be necessary to carry it
out & that all reports being ~~being~~ taken ~~at~~ proceeded
