

Had a very good lunch & after a nap went out to see the Chateau for 100 years it had been a barracks but has been cleaned up. Some good galls. Roman mosaics discovered on the level & Roman foundations. I then went toward the wells - the river well & got a parcel of photographs (5 p). I then drove to the Post Office after a cup of tea & looked the fine mosaic in the town hall. I missed the hotel which I intended (10) & went to bed.

May 10. Up in good time, packed, went up to the city again. Picking up my guide book which I had left in a shop. I wandered round the river between the two lines of fortifications, & took me a two photographs. Had lunch in the same place came back Albi & caught a train at 2.10 - to Castelnau & 40 min. with then to Carles 1 hour with the Albi. Stayed at Terminus.

May 11. Went out & saw the Cathedral of red brick standing up such a fine I went up to the main passage the statue of the Virgin & a statue of Albi & then left the Cathedral. The light was very pale. I got me a two photos & then went into the Cathedral. It is a magnificent place especially the 5th choir. I took three photos inside. Then round the Chapel & the choir & after walking round the base of the west end I got photos from the railway bridge, after lunch went back & crossed the bridge & saw the museum (from) back & saw the Rodg.

Rodg I saw a station Rodg & saw a man for the train waiting so I got out & left by bag & took my machine up me. I stopped at the Benny.

May 12. Chilled very cold, my book one broken in the train. Heard news at the Cathedral & walked round interesting especially two stone coffins of 14 & 15th cent. back for lunch & drove for 1.10 to Sévères I was taken to the bank - Rodg is a good 2 Kilometres from the station & the main station, & I crossed by bag & went there. Missed my train but the chef de gare had it sent up from Rodg Particles of a train coming there. Repacked all my baggage & changed & started. & caught the 4 o'clock train - a slow M.V. on the Sévères. (Hôtel Madame)

Mullon Left Clotier 14 worked but dinner & went on to Mullon & got there 10.20 went to Hotel Terminus

May 13. Left at 5.17 & off to 6 o'clock bus, after leguense on begins to get better but the hills do not begin to close in till Le Puy in which is on the left bank of the river. After the Viguer the Viguer de Dames. At Neuluss we stopped for lunch 8-8.30. I was glad to get some Albi - then on to 5.17 ^{at 5.30} Neuluss, where I got off the bus. Which was on to Florac. After walking round the Albi - little village, I set off back back & walked & early then the right bank joining St. Chay & then which is on the left bank, the plain cliffs of Puygarron, & stopped for lunch at the Chateau de la Page are old Chateau of XV cent. was a comfortable hotel. After a sleep I walked on to Neuluss about 11.11. in all - about 4.30 I went into the church on long crossing of about 11 cent. The aisle was 6 ft. wide - the pillars 4 ft 6. the nave 11 ft. After changing I started Albi - my feet being rather sore.

Mullon May 14. Went to Mass at 7.15 - a very nice - some birds. The birds about placed in the altar space in which the soil for the grain & the stream which he read. I got off & walked down. The limestone rock on of a red where there was red weather & clay. A ruined Chateau on the left bank. Just before the gorge I saw a broad & high & a little cottage & across the river about 200 yds a man after it. This is the first part of the river, then comes the bridge de Dames where the river seems blocked with boulders. Below the gorge I walked & saw bringing his sheep across the river. He used one of the ordinary long flat-bottomed boats. The sheep were exactly what I do, they walked on without any fear & packed themselves across the boat - just leaving room for the Shepherd & his pole then over. He brought the flock over in 3 minutes. At Le Viguer I had lunch at the H. Passions. The river itself is more open but the cliffs above very fine. There is a cavern natural level 4 ft up from the river 25 m wide & 27 m high.

I passed the big expression hotel de Rogier & walked on to Rogier itself on the left bank - about 2.20 for Neuluss. I had a coffee & caught a bus at 5 o'clock up to Neuluss up the very fine valley of the Jure. I stopped at the Hotel de France. After dinner there was a procession with a band & Chinese lanterns & a few fireworks being the festival of St. John of the

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
