Aug 21. I went to the station at 7.30 & after breakfast at the station walked up to the Hotel de viajeros, about 2 km away. The road valley is 300 m above sea level in a rocky peninsula with the hot flowing river at it. The walls still stand to a large extent & it is well worth a visit. From Café de viajeros I saw, so we went to the Jaramila Hotel & then to R. & Clara de la... then left; along the way up the hill there were terraced roads & so on a S. by car track. Just below the cliffs on which the village stands there R. along a path which goes below the walls with a view down to the L. & the ten and center of the town "Dajun". I got back to hotel had a sleep with my diary - repacked. Showed some scenery after dinner with letters.

Aug 22. Went to Mass. Caught the 10.17 train to Figeas. Found ten 4 o'clock bus for S. C. at the station & put my baggage in it. Went into the town saw the two churches. Interesting but no photographs. Had lunch at a little inn on the railway side of the river - great good & cheap. Had a sleep. Walked round Figeas again & caught the auto. at 4. At La Chapelle narrow 1/2 the hall. got me fresh of auto. The Chichester was no photo. had some coffee. Every where were spruce trees with alsema, it. heard an very doubtful of water below very and. Many of the fields covered with a purple wild lupine. Got a photo of an old volcano climbing at 4 p.m. I stopped at the Hotel de Paris S. C. The car 7 km down was very fine

Aug 23. Went to Mass at 6.45. Could get no information about buses in Arege. Got off 5.30 & walked to the house. across & approached it from the L. got 2 photos. saw the

bed at the Chichester, emerged to see so photographed the Café de viajeros then the gate. took the auto to the S. C. saw a 2 story village with several terraced houses. Church with good carved capitals & a large porch. Could see the road & would be S. heard nothing but & then took a lane that led me to the hills & to Antonio got there first

after 12. Church good etc. Carved bases to the pillars of the door - took a photo of one. Aided of town had been a general & a large funeral party was taking place just above the church. The village was vast several blocks. Set off at 2 & walked up to Chichester des Aydes. found path to Army Museum & generally bad going. The bed way of it was to the S with & went back.
