

Austria 1833 (Streuner)

July 17. Up at 3, stirring hobbled for the Weisshagel, we got off at 6
in 10 inches of new snow & walked under Hausebuck past the
Sindalm hut; it was the top of the Tristal Spitzé was in deep wind
& snow so we did not go up it. After lunch we went up steeply on
the rocks, I earned a stocking boot & bed of g.

July 18. We got off at 5:30 & got to the top of the Sindalm at 7:30 on a
glorious day, we left at 7:30 & went down on the Glatz glacier
& across to the Margelljoch & got to the top of the Hintere Schwärze
at 8:30 had just 8 dm Margell glacier. The snow was good till a
gr. down on the lower part we got off on the morning on the left bank
just above the last snow fall 11.28 - 11.45. I saw a Chamois
on the Margellward & then go back round the foot of the M. W.
to Säumerhut 12.5. Tod. Long way I saw a man
had cows on the Sindalm joch trying many packets of cigarettes.
Wine & & sleep.

July 19. Left 3 & off at 4:15, stayed down below hut. Crossed the end of
the Margell glacier & up the Schafj glacier, when we got to
the wide open tract we turned left up rocks down to the
Daim Scherli & to the top of the Schafj Kugel at 10.8.
We had some food & slept at 8:30 & went down the Schafj Kugel just
to the Fidelia hut: 9.50 - 10.20 down to the New Karlsruhe hut
11.30 from here 12.30 & walked down to Gugl. Had a bath
paid off Gottfried with letters etc. Got D.O.A.V badge
arranged to meet Sophie in Jezs 25th at 8 but for Weisshagel if he had no engagement
and 2 men at 7. Daugay said man - no bretta - very simple
ritual. Majority of women & girls with no hat or hand kerchief, most of them
took the Sacrament. Rearranged luggage. Found my bag
was an 20 Kilos & had to get the boat & send it down.

July 21. Off 5:45 & walked down to J. Weisshagel 7:45. There was no anch-
or sold for sun time so I arranged for my bag to wait on L' Landek
& walked keeping to the R. bank (blue marks) & following road of
above Pletten crossed a bridge which had all the big grass
steps in the first ten between Burdauf hut & the Chelchi alm
S olden

I left J. Weisshagel at 8:10 & stopped for food of a spring water windash that
of the path about 1/2 km below high. I left at 11 & walked Steingut
on. Since I had a shelter under rocks for rain & it was first raining
when I got to the Hütte herein Nov. 2. 45. The weather seemed bad.
A guide came up till we met Gottfried had a large engagement,
then I crossed him, with some English friends & then he waved with his
hand for the Weisshagel. I again knew him at the B.B. hut on the night.

July 22. The morning looked better, I got up at 3 & off at 4, up to the Pfaffenjoch & across
to the Pfaffen salted & up the head east ridge to the top of the Zellerkogel. 6:45.
I had food on the top. The wind was nothing, the Dolomites stood up very black
& lowering air full of a yellowish red sky. I left at 7:20 had 5 min after food
& wine back at the 8:9. The snow was good except the last bit.
I had a snack & waited down at 8:35. On the descent instead of following
the new road I had crossed, I went down the old road which kept to the
Gaisbach trail. This is much easier for the descent. I had a hell for a
drink of tea from the Jenes & got down to Pödele at 12:35. I had
an amulet & some wine & my 1:35 auto back to J. Weisshagel.
Had a short & change 15 min off my second day & had L' Landek.

July 23. A drizzling morning. Went to hut at 6, again the celebrated bad weather
& now after wine & girls better. The gospel was in German. The
ritual was very simple, the sermon was rather pointed. I had dinner
at the Post & left at 12:45 & walked up to Vord. via
S Colib Kogel - was having a shelter as it came as worse. I got in
at 4:15 & stopped at the Post. Change & had tea - still drizzling.

July 24. Looked out at 3 looked very bad, slept till 7:15 - was just starting to
go down in despair when a blizzard of snow came, got off at 8:30 &
set off for the Vord. at 11:45. I hopped for snow food & oil & tea
10:30 - 11 just below Pletten. I got to the ridge below the hut at 12:15
& was at the hut 12:35. I had food & sleep. I hopped on Schiff &
Johnson had gone off late to the Wildspitze. I waited & had a cup of tea
but they had not arrived & I set off at 3:30 leaving word for the guide
to follow. I went 5 way & got to the Druckerberg hut at 5:15 & the
B.B. hut at 6. & by the time we arrived in clouds. The guide
turned up later on.
