

Austria 1834.

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July 13 Got up in good time & caught the 7:55 train of 1st class from Salzburg, Wester & Ratten & thought it was about 15 sec. - an "Alpenreise picket", being slow in the rain & carrying to the Neustadt train. Got to Gmunden 12:30. Went off by 1st class & saw & caught 1:35 1st class. One pillar 4:10. Got a cup of coffee & coffee at 4:45 & got the other train at 6:10. Rained in rain completely & cheap. Walked till late this way 12.

July 14 Off at 8:10. Apparently walking over road in course of construction 1st class - coffee 11:11:40. Worked on for 3/4 hr & had lunch out - attended to business - rain came as fast as got under a tree. Then at 1:50 got the last 1st class train at 3:10. I had picked up a Society Austrian, he stayed for 2 weeks & was on. At the Gigstein Inn it looks like a thunderstorm has - I stopped the coffee & coffee 3:50 1:5:10. I went down 1st class - there is a stone bridge under Kremstal where the station is - with fine veins of the Waterfall, many old stones & buried eggs & shells & some black whale articles Kremstal & the last was. Was when the valley narrow. I stood two rods for the road but I followed a good line. Until last steady & firmly took me up to the top Kremstal & solid out to West, Kremstal till 6:30. In last train again at 8:30 I stopped but the Böckelberg didn't complete.

July 15 Up early & caught the 8:45 1st class. was also getting them 11:30 went to Zell am See & expected his lunch & went out, frequent stops. I stopped in various cases & Grindelwald got back finished quickly. Warm day after Supper.

July 16 A dull morning. Goldgras schiff arrived & morning having come from Sölden with day. Rain came again. packed & had tea at a better morning, getting by off of post & was back & caught the 8 o'clock train up to Kresselfell in the Kaprun thal. He started to walk at 9:10 & was up as high as 1st class & had a rest at the top of the first cliff. 10:30 - 10:35 then along a flat & up another slope 3:30 & got 1st class back at 11:30. In hand

July 17 poor & dear. Then asleep - it was too cold to sleep outside. Then off at 2:30 & with 2 hats got to Hinterer Schwarzenbach - at 5:55 - 2802. I took the

July 18 We got off at 5 & hopped at 5:40 after top of the rocks. Off 5:50 1st class Wörthersee 6:40. here I took left track & got off at 7:5. 1st class 1st class to G. Weißbach 8:40. Here wet & windy & we got off down at 8:10 & got back to our sacks at 8:30. We started off 8:45 along the Wörthersee & over the Bratschberg pass. By this time it was getting very cloudy & the two other parties turned back. At 10:15 we were at the top of the Gletscher & got down the Grubenscharte when we had food 10:45 - 1:11:30. I was very tired, but revived after food. We kept near the N ridge from the G. Bärnbögg & to the Kaiserscharte. The fog was very dense & I believe that we climbed up the Schneigerkopf. Any how we turned to the left & came down miserable with new snow on them. Suddenly the fog lifted & we found that we were going down into the Kaprun thal. We turned left again & climbed up cliff snow & soon found ourselves in the Eiswandschlucht. We stopped down the Bockkar Schlucht & had a small meal. 3:3:28 & then walked down to the Oberwalder hutte which we reached at 3:50. Had "the water" & slept. The last fair fell.

July 19 After a talk with Goldgras in the long morning, he finally got off at 9:40 & walked down 1st the Hinterer hut - & crossed the glacier just alone it's & made our way up the path on the Gletscher hump. Half past 10:30 went top of the rocks 9:45 - 10:15. Down the hut at 10:30. We had small meal 11:40 - 11:50 then up to the ridge & finally reached Adlerschuh hut (Erbergg Johann) 3:45 at 12:30. I slept. They we saw we the birds of this mountainous region on the snow at the Kaiserscharte below the col between the 2 gletschers. Both were good climbing, but the second was a' coming 1st class. Schartl had jumped in crampers & very common Austrian hump - & the 1 in 1000 cases happened. the snow was thin & we both of us crampers wedged in one uneven crack in the rock & threw him off his balance & he tumbled to the other men with him. The clouds were quite clear when we passed next morning. The was some snow & a very cold wind. After food he a sleep.
