

July 20. We got off at 5:30. Gottfried had borrowed a pair of crampons for me, but they didn't fit & the left one finally came right round my boot facing the other foot. The climbing was not difficult, tho' it all centered walking. We were at the top at 7. I there was practically no view as we were in fog all the time. We left at 7:25 & were across the hut at 8. We packed & had a plate of soup & set off at 9:30 & again much less after Stüttl hut at 10:40. We had a meal - very well cooked. The woman was very doubtful of my photo in the D.O.A.V. number & said & Gottfried had it called in to identify us. We got off at 12:15 down a very steep path keeping the left bank all the time (below it might be with Cervin (bridge at 1800 m level) & got down into the Kälber Thal at 2:15. We went round the corner & had hell leaving at 2:30. We had ten reasons of an the first being Rameau. 3:45 - 4:50 & got to the Kälber Jägerhütte 1950 at 4:20. & had some tea & got a sandwich. At the Stüttl hut they told us that a break will made on the Freiburg-Schart (the Kälber Jägerhütte).

July 21. Came up slowly, we got off at 5:20 & crossing the ridge went slowly up a new red marked path which is shown at the 1:100,000 map. We found the track had been forgotten, so a lot of coins & chocolates 7:20 - 7:45. & he wellies took remarkable threatening. However when we came to the pole <sup>P. 60</sup> there must the pass we set off N.E. & climbed to K. Münsterberg 10:20 leaving our sacks at the hut. There was a rubber walk down with a wire rope & mostly wall up & the wellies took so bad & we were both pretty tiring. We left at 10:35 & took down under the rocks of the S.S.W ridge which is the continuation of the Münsterberg but better & now. We picked up our sacks had 5 min rest & were with Sachsenstein Deutobit Mts. 11:30. The direct descent from the Münsterberg to Landest Säge was very bad & tiring. A big cloud there. We left at 2:30 & at the Aueren Steinm Alp saw a 150, leaving the last hut on our left. Presently it began to get dark & from 4:30 - 4:40

Gottfried was exhausted. - When I Gottfried's delight. Then came a "Schwein hau". It pelted with rain & then hauled. The 2nd break because very bad & we were awfully in this place. So I was very tired & it was raining pretty steadily. We had heard that there would Mass at the Matreis Jägerhütte when it started but as it was a Saturday. But at the Landest Säge they told us there was nothing. So rather thoroughly we turned in. In a few days I had been bothered with a bit on my right arm about 2 inches below the armpit & it had been quite painful. So I took out what was in the pocket bag.

July 22 left at 7:45 & got to the Matreis Jägerhütte at 8:15. I found my face was peeling, tho' I had not. Suspected it to be it's shaved & found this - then shaved off c 600 old skin. We treated the hit with hot poultices but nothing much happened. It was not very complete & very cheap & the people very willing.

July 23 a wonderful morning. Saw a stag & a fox running past using the water & then Gottfried announced Honey please. And I said. I got some honey & bread from the "Spötter". Watched them feeding at least in the stream. They got 6 & died. There is the stream I had done myself very nicely this. & the hit for 2 or 3 days we are 2500. & they were by then's side.

July 24 We got off at 8. We passed Chastel down out of the work at G Schloss. At dinner got some coffee. Two old German Breslauer bobby about. I do not know how are they got up there. 9:00 C.S. 20 - got to the Allen Prager hut at the last for 11 - 12:45 <sup>2500</sup> & got to the Prager hut at 1. I did my chores. It was at 5 am. 2 parties of 2 came up & camped in the Venediger. I got a dock to hold all my gear as it was full of eggs.

July 25 Left at 4 was to bed seeing sun did not go outside. Heard that this of day of 3 had been climbing & climbing for the Allen Prager hut & had not returned. They say he goes down to Baden & refugee in a mountain.
