

July 26. Started all night. Drove 12 miles up new road. Then it gradually improved after road Gottfried had not even started up L-3057.

A pony came up & told us of Dolomites reservation. A party of 20 Detachments came up.

July 27. Up at 3:45 dressed & down the mountain, went to bed at 6:00 - raining hard up to 5:45. put on the robe at 6:45. To & little wind & 3 feet. And not less 10 yards ahead. An pony went off to the Venetians (of course remained) he found no way & turned back to the Col between the two Venetians & got up all sides of rocky & chalky hillsides where he found a specimen of the Mt. Vener. & knew no place to turn, so Gottfried suddenly saw a path below coming up from the Kaisergeb. In about an hour & except for the disappearance of the ponies were up. He started off at 10:15 & was soon found & leaving at 10:45 got to the Kaisergeb. sleep & complete bus. At 11:20 had food & left.

July 28. Wrote to an early morning decided to go down. he left at 6. I believe it was one of them days with a West Wind when he could have climbed the Geiger. We got to the Kaisergeb. at 10:30 first hearing the S. 10 from Kaisergeb. Had food at a Campfleth Alpine Verein caught the 12:10 Zell am See 14:15 got coffee bus - 14:32 got to St. Johann at 17:05. Gottfried went on down & went to the Scenic.

July 29. Up early & was in town enough luggage more 11 letters went to Berg Hotel for lunch - Cost & wine breeze came back & took a photo of the Goldenen Damm. to tea with a diary. Weather still wetting & clouds obscuring the hills.

July 30. Up early slept packed 140. met Montgomery & his wife in the fleetroom. We went in the "Aussicht-Wagen" to get the auto up from Brixenthal. They got off at Langenfeld & went on to Sölden where met Gottfried. I stayed in his recommendation at "Grüner Alpenverein" completely clean & cheap but avoid a window facing the church & the church. I had got some nice "second hand" in Innsbruck & cleaned the girl which has a lot of hair & a fresh coat & fresh piece of cloth. It looks very nicely.

Aug 1. Had breakfast at 7:15. Gottfried left & said that he has been ill with pneumonia for a week - & he had the doctor who told him that he was a full week of Monday. I lay in bed. I washed up & took all the things & the car down where he was confined. I got off at 8:25 & walked up to Fiegl's Winkels where I had coffee & rolls 10:25 - 11:5. In an hour I was at the station of the peters & there was a stop at 12:15 - with half an hour to leave. About 15 min. between Leopoldsdorf and the Sölden Gottfried coming up as fast pace so I waited for him & we got to the bus at 2:30. His brother & the Stutterer - two people came on with a guide from the whole company.

Aug 1. A wet morning. he left at 8:45. I packed my coat & umbrella by rack wearing the sweater. he stopped at Fiegl at 10:30 - 11:5 & got down to Sölden at 12:10. The mountains had just gone over. he had only got down to meadow dry. I got my coat & dried D. & M. had made "repaired".

Aug 2. Cleared after 6:30 am & left for Weisensee at 6:50 & walked up in the shade along the lake shore where I had coffee at Grüner Alpenverein a continuation of the Sölden one. Dotsch & the Mohrenland (a continuation of a drei Mohren of Brix) were clean & fresh, very cheap. Left again at 8:40. I was at the Elektric Obergail at 9:30. James had Montgomery at breakfast. He was ready & still in his room. Clark & myself were in an hotel with 3 guy Englishmen. I met Wybrough who is the other hotel & said him in the Obergail section. Gottfried came up & we arranged to climb the Grünalpe ridge tomorrow.

Aug 3. I got up at 7:30 to an egg morning with a South wind. I had breakfast & went to sleep again. awoke again & had another breakfast at 9. We walked up to the other hotel & met 2 very nice men are members of this section. Mr. letters. Called at the Danglers. had dinner & left. now late, wet night.

Aug 4. remained here all night. Went to market. Walked up to the top of the mountain & wheel. Walk with Montgomery & Peter & then went up to the church. Was the 1<sup>st</sup> pillar and had himself charmed.
