

Aug 5th Went to house at 8 - Roopy - Lammun Serrum Mass. Walked
 Guy (Holt) house & left. Then up with Hengel.

Aug 6th I had set my camera trap & did not get off till 6.10. Was started off up the
 road the new cemetery with the Verwood road & got to the glacier at 8.30 had a sack of
 food & left at 8.45 & got to the Col. W. of the Grand Hotel at 10. The Schland was
 quite easy, we had 5 men. I left an sack on the Col & started up the rock
 ridge with a series of teeth - small laboratory - got to the top at 11 in a 9 hour
 day. We had some food & left again at 11.25 & was on a sack on the Col at 12.5.
 I understood Göttschid & say we had better go down & wait as the new snow
 might come to 5000 & fall down the gully so at 12.10 we started off
 climbing up a little & then leaning west & traversing a good deal
 of rather loose down sloping rocks & then down still leaning west
 down & left again when we found a good deal of calcareous & crossed
 the actual snow of the glacier & halted for lunch on the ^{old} Mercurius. We
 left at 2.15 & climbed up the plain slope E of the ^{old} Mercurius &
 descended some finding a good path which took us to the ski hut at 3.15
 where we had food & tea & rest & left at 4.50 got to the new
 Karlshut hut at 6. When we stopped for the night. I found
 a fine bluish needles by the hut.

Aug 7th Stockwille We got off at 4.15 & went up the valley that & got to the glacier & put on the
 rope 6.30 - 6.45. We climbed round the left side of the glacier.
 We found a pair of 6 emyglers above the hut to the Stockwille
 school was very clean on the other side of the glacier (left side)
 the got very little snow till 1/2 the below the Stockwille school
 there we halted 7.50 - 8.0. There was a wonderful view over the valley
 a sea of cloud with peaks rising out of it. The Dolomites standing
 out prominently well. We got to the top of the Stockwille at 8.30
 nearly dark & hazy at the time we got down. We had food & left at 8.55
 & then down the rock ridge which is very much decorated with stragglers
 & rope - possibly for winter climbing. The snow on the glacier justifying
 was good & we were at the Fideleis (old Karlshut) at 10.55.
 We had some tea & I cut off at 11.20 & got to the new Karlshut at 12.50
 we had food & left again at 1.30 & got picking up an overcast. & got to
 the Ski hut at 2.15 just as a storm was beginning. We arrived in

had tea & got off again after dinner was on at 3.10 got to Geyse at 3.50.
 I had some & missed to eat & then at 4.10 & 4.30 ^{by 4} the number
 of the Obligation Section had the President (Dangler) the Treasurer & the Sec. (Geyse)
 with Dinner. They decided an excellent Dinner & to be very pleasant evening
 I am on 10 of us. After Dinner the as it was the 60th Anniversary of the
 founding of the Obligation Section used their scene than the "Karlshut" of
 Geyse & that it was the original Section of the D. O. A. V. & that
 I am was really one of the founders of the D. O. A. V. Many very legends.
 We ended about 11 o'clock.

Aug 8th up late - an off day. did nothing - till for dinner 6.50 each
 sleep in afternoon then mended Knives. wrote Weibing for money.

Aug 9th packed - went to Mass. Sent baggage down, picked up by bus at the Geyse
 hotel & walked down to Weissstein with him 11.30. He was very quiet, I saw
 the driver & told him to stand my baggage on the Stambuch & I was on my train at
 Sölden. I got off & walked down seeing Göttschid & Schip on road. Got to
 Sölden at 12.40 & had lunch. Göttschid arrived, but I had to wait till
 4.10 when the auto came back. P. An came in & leading so I saw
 Göttschid home & stayed at the Alpenhaus.

Aug 10th We got off at 8 & got to Fiegl's at 8.45 & had coffee & bread & left at
 10.25 & got to the top of the Schindler hut at 1.25. I had lunch & did
 my things in the room. I was the only person in the tent.

Aug 11th up at 4.30 & off at 6.15. I stopped to take a couple of clouds
 of the Stockwille while the rope was put on. Got to 7.45 - 8. We got to the top
 at 8.45. A fine morning but overcast & dark cloud about
 especially in the west. We left at 9 & walked down west down
 rocks & climb down & across to the Karlshut (Karlshut) in the
 Chies Linn) between the Wilder Pfaff & the W. Fiegl & the P. Goffmanns -
 at 9.45 had some food & left at 10.15 & got to the Reiche hut
 at 10.15. This had to be notably comfortable hut, but since
 the Italians have had it, it has become dirty & the food bad. So
 many of them but a corporal's guard is stationed to prevent anyone being
 taken down since the glacier still & they do not mind the cleanliness of the
 place - no better except of a few visitors are at the hut & the only fire
 is in the kitchen. I saw the hut has a chapel attached "St. Maria im Schnee"
