Two ladies from Holland came down, they were going to the Dresden
hall. At 8.25 we set off in a steady fall of fine snow. We got
to the rock point at 8.50 & the top of the Wilde Frieze at 9.23.
We halted at 9.40. At this time the snow almost got thick. We
left at 9.40 & took old tracks covered & snow covered tho' looked
as if they came from the Himmelsberg; but following in tracks for
we found ourselves as the clouds lifted just above the Wilde
Frieze & Schale. We got down at 10.35 & had some mince-
cake & a mouthful of bread & butter & a drink of tea sitting
under the lee of a rock. We left at 10.55 & followed down

11.55. After 5 min to take the rope off & finished the tea used
off & got to the Himmelsberg at 12.25. Where we got
an excellent meal. I paid off & got paid all but 50 Schilling
which I send next day from Jansbuck. I paid for Aug 13

Aug 14. A wet morning. I went out & did a little shopping. After lunch and had
cleaned I took the train up to S. Himmelsberg, but from the afternoon
light all way for the old house. I was back at 10. I had a
train back to Jansbuck. I finished my packing & after 2 min went
to the J. Himmelsberg at the Maria Theresia Restaurant. One of the men in

Aug 15. I caught the 7.20 & got all my baggage in the carriage. I had two very old
ladies in the carriage & when they got out - 4 old ones got in - quite amusing to

hotel of the station Hotel Alpen. I was at the station garden & house and
got my baggage after waiting the big bag of linen to Grindelwald.

Jansbuck
Aug 16. I packed & sent off my bag of post & caught the 8.10 boat for
Engelberg & took the light up to G. Himmelsberg & the Grand railway
(8 min) to Jansbuck at 12.20. I got my room & took a light to
& walked a little beyond the hotel & had lunch - my I had
my attention used. At 1.30 I set off & got to the rock & top before
the first glacier up to the Tittel at 3.20. A party of 2 had
just come down but there was a good deal of snow & it was

Aug 17 after 6.45 the post for 7.50 leaving at 8.10. I had a cup

rock well - obviously some fault in the line & base. I got down
to Jansbuck at 2 & had coffee leaving at 2.30. As it was
very hot I took the short cut to the R. Himmelsberg which saves
much steeper road. I got to Willing at 3.45 had a beer & some bread
