- Oct 7 Sunday. Rather a rough night. I had a celebration at 7:45. It
was 27°. Slept well in anatomy. The Captain said that he would not
conduct the Morning Service, but no notice was passed. After dinner
I had a long sleep, when I woke up there was a sort of procession
along side. I served a "case" with my sword canister & took a
shot at level. Every at 8:15 with children. Weather seems clearing.
Oct 8. Mon. A fine morning with sun. Played deck golf in morning. Slept in
28°. Afternoon. A beautiful day & temperature quite pleasant.
Oct 9. Tues. Weather very pleasant. Luggage room open. Weighed 187 lbs
325. to 135°. Played deck golf. In evening passed a ship
Oct 10. wed. Waves visible on starboard side when on port on
deck. Took a photo. Went to Cinema of
328. Assassination of King Alexander of Serbia & H. Dalton
at Marseilles. — In 1801 we had word of President
Kosciusko's Assassination while at sea. A head wind
which with the boat's speed had built a strong wind on port side.
Slept after dinner. Had a light rain after dinner
Oct 11. Thurs. Another beautiful day - calm sea & pleasant if not strong
323. breeze. Ship Committee meeting, we elected members. One
passenger reported flying fish. Sailed setting V. last.
rain after dinner.
Oct 12. Fri. A Ship Committee meeting in morning. Beautiful clouds ahead.
317. Slept. Played games. flying fish alarm. Wrote letters.
Oct 13. Sat. Getting very warm. Walked on sun deck played games
317. Slept - Sat - till noon. Sails for game committee 3:45 - 4:30.
Oct 14. Sun. Ship Inspection 8:5. At 7:45: 12 present.
305. Captain with 11 o'clock & looked it very well. Very hot
last evening opened at 8:30 in after lounge
Oct 15. Mon. Played deck golf. Swimming both rigged up. fine dinner.
318. Deck Crochet. Played after dinner.
Oct 16. Tues. A couple of books came, but I missed them, got things
329. from Duggys room. Played cards. A fair dinner. Saw on
the horizon, & on the Port Rio French 4000 fathoms.
Oct 20. 13. Saw Submarine light close shore.

- Oct 17. Wed. Slept on deck today with shiny & warm &
334. blanket. A hot day. Had a following current which
helped the steam. Very tired after dinner, did not go to concert.
Slept on deck.
Oct 18
316. Celebration at 7:45: 12 present. Played off deck games &
we became so hot in following. Saw some islands & passing
local & light house first. Heard 44 ton rollers. Passed S. of
Curacao, the long ugly line of blackish reefs runs along British
Cuba 1,00000 lbs of plaster on sand bank. passed by and
the entrance to Curacao Bay where the last lake of oil
for the Dutch Refinery which job it's now will from
Venezuela. is evidently part of the "Shell" combine
in greater with sand bank & with a long l.
Williamson - the Capital. The river was jet black. We
passed through making a better road to Curacao Bay
with a massive gun mounted on them. Sailed past bay
anything. We had tea at a hotel & dined back.
The people who had not agreed the dinner had a row. The
usual charge is 4/6 a head for a first class. The ship
got off at 5:45 & arrived the lights of Willemstad
to our absolute amazement following day. the night clear

morning. We saw the coast of Venezuela. Played at
Deck golf apparently. Then wrote letters.
The second time we had the had just seen the end
of Venezuela the famous "Cape de Virga" was
really in Colombia & the end of the scene.
Oct 20
288. A cool breeze night. Left well until past 4:30.
After the passengers for Curacao & Panama.
We are due about 6 am. dinner at 12 o'clock
4:30 stay over & be careful if necessary.
Swallows came aboard off the 1st & 2nd watch after dinner.
