

4743. Oct 21. Sunday. Looked up at 6 & watched the light of dawn & then

153 the sunrise. I got up at 5:45 & got ready for celebration at 7:15. The boat got away quickly & we were in the ^{Galea} hurricane lock before it was over. The lock is in three stages. We had breakfast at 8:30

I tried to get fish of one of the Chinese boys going by the window between the lock sections. There is a large ladder passed the Ocean aerial at 9:30. There is a narrow channel very slow. Got a lot of crew playing cards. The Gallard & Caldeira cut where they had trouble at first when the canal was opened (Aug 15 1899) I saw a couple of alligators basking in the cut. The Galea lake surrounded with islands is very fine. We crossed the divide at 11 & at 12:30 were at the Peli Hospital Lock & single one then across the very yellow Hurricane Lake & the double Hurricane lock at 12:15. We had lunch at 12:30 & saw some old ferret dredge & some lenses & some other some American submarines in the water - sanked by Morgan in 1647 then back to Panama Canal with the other gardens & drinks & got back at the lock at 6. Left at 10:10 pm

The Canal is about 27 miles & runs from N.W. to S.E. - Panama is full of lakes. Galea lake is 55 ft above sea level. The deep are used then the locks of Chinese work. I am lost here.

Oct 22. Mon. The wind was on the starboard side & it was warm on deck sleeping, we could still see Cape Mala - part of Panama on the starboard side. Very nice & little tired after the day ashore. Played deck golf after deck 5-6 pm

Oct 23. 278 we are in cloudy damp weather, it was cold at night & on deck read & worked in morning. Played deck golf after deck after tea

Oct 24. 289 Slept on deck & got up of wind & was very comfortable. Wrote in ship & coal 155 lbs. At 10. am we were 0.01 from the line, may be some 1/2 out of the Golden Gate. A S. Trades & better weather.

Oct 26. Friday had two blankets & slept well & warm. A warty

Oct 28. Sunday. It was a warmer night & the sun got up in full force celebration 7:45 (19 breakfast) The Captain was well as usual

316 like the 11 o'clock service. One of the pleasantest days we have had. Mr. Wetmore is taking the evening service.

Oct 29. Mon. A warm night - & a fine day clear day as

303 then we was in. later it became cooler. played deck golf all morning. I got an excellent sketch of myself in my chair from Gen. Demore who had made some excellent sketches. The P.M. Meeting was in the evening.

Oct 30. T. I woke up at 5 & could not get to sleep again. I watched an very wonderful sunrise as I lay in my chair on

301 deck. After I was up I spotted what looked like a Sunday of smoke yellowing my glasses & saw a vessel - the Yacuzzi - which passed us about 8:5. during breakfast.

Oct 31. W. A pleasant night, played deck golf in afternoon & deck before lunch.

293 Nov 1. All Saints. The wind had shifted & blown from the "Treasure Hunt" had 11 but off. At night the ladies had the par. side & I moved me to the starboard - still above. In the night the wind shifted to the port side! Celebration at 7:45

298 a fine morning. played in afternoon. P.M. Meeting at 11:30. long & wearisome. rain again in evening. Treasure Hunt in evening.
