281 Wed. Nov. 7. The weather is now quite cool - Saw an albatross

Wed. Nov. 14. 40 days from London & 23pm Pitcairn Islands
We went to Wellington cargo & getting supplies & our tickets - but
this before breakfast. Shanks Sec. & Mac - members of
the N.L.A.C. came on board. He is in the customs & you are given 1 -
pound bag can & Lyttellon. I was ashore & bought a few things & then
had dinner with Shanks. We left at 4 pm - my 2o birthday.

Thurs. Nov. 15. We are in Lyttellon about 7. Hawthorn was on the
train. I saw the car loaded & took my cabin luggage as
of course to C. A. having the car & the boat luggage to follow.

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
