One old camp on the Tarnan side & started to back to camp side. We got a good deal done & then a huge valde belid us up & we had to wait again about 6 ft - further on. We had food at 3 & then built up the walls & pitched the fly. I changed a film in the camera at 6. We were using a little No 70 Prisms which did remarkably well using up 1/3 of a gallon for the whole trip. I had my rubber air mattress & found it most comfortable if not blown up too tight.

Jan 31

We were up at 1 & off at 3. We kept to the right below Jores & got into camp at 10. We had a bad start but we got on the ice when the head of the canyon is seen by. It was really very good to get on the ice as they had been before. We then had a bad start to the ice of the rocks on our left. In the afternoon at 5:30 & 6:00 we were in the Col between Jores & Tarnan. We could round the back of Jores & see in the end was a good snow covered trail old glacier had shown. It was a very good surprise.

I could soon have been talked of following ice to the whole of Jores. We planned with care. So we returned & took Portia back up on the ridge of Jores crossing the ice & cleared, at the top of them & a horse of ice to the top of the ridge & then we were back. Jack Cox got on the ridge at 7:30, but the rocks were very cold & I knew it was a long way & the ice was not too good so we returned. It was windy & cloud were falling so we returned to my down had to pass. At 8:30 we went back to the camp at 10:40. I was very tired. We had food & sleep. The bad weather was coming up as I called up the end of the fly. While there we heard a large bear from

Packed up & saw just cloud of it at 2 pm we heard later that Frank Black & a party from the mission for excellent names. Bora Black had just got this same pack. We heard in long but rain came on at 12:30 & we slept in.

Feb 1

We got up at 8 & tried up the line inside the fly. The Prisms were muffled but blocked & we had a long job clearing it. As it cleared in at 11 after lunch & got on to Parnan Ridge & followed it along till we came to the snow. Jack Cox was on the Prisms & found with Dr. Brewster had climbed down & got up & returned of Hunter Pass. We had by back to the side of the hills of the Prisms.

Adventure on Parnan Ridge. When they were 5 then found for 10 days & found a little water. A fellow & a black bucket & some light food. We returned to the camp at 5:45.

The prison had been properly cleaned & blocked again. Feb 3. The other went off for Tarnan at 2:15. I decided to go to the back of the snow. I was very long & the snow was not too good. I had to go to the side of the pass on the Tarnan ridge. At 6:30 I saw some Argentinian Col, the snow showing long shadows. They were very high & the sky at full extent. At 6:55 they disappeared on the Ceruleity side. I washed up, took samples, tried to clean the Prisms. Validated the Prisms & the Tarnan had been seen. The first ridge was all up & down. I then saw some in the top of it. The snow did not get on the ice - at 10:30. I had a long station in the air. Validated a snow & dry descending from the Prisms at 12:45. Saw some snow below the Prisms. Beyond that the hills are high. They got back at 2:45 after a long day. They saw a little things inside. A wonderful red glass on Tarnan in the evening.

Cox told me that the whole of the Prisms on the Prisms side of Tarnan had fallen off & my Prisms were shown & also that the first record of the peak was shown. I had been thinking of suggesting going up to Jores sleeping in the Col between it & Tarnan & climbing it. Last day but the report was so discouraging that I gave up all idea of it.

Feb 3

We got off at 7:40 & went across to the Prisms of Tarnan & climbed to the top of the Prisms. We got to the top of the Prisms & went back. It was one of the days when we heard that the rocks would fall on the other side but fell to the side. We were back at camp at 10:45 & had tea & biscuits & left at 11 & were at the camp at 11:45. We had food & then took the camp down & packed up things & set off at 1:50. We found a rock that the ice fell well and very up. We got to Prisms at 4:10 & left at 4:25. They got some film for Harry Hult left & we got to the hill at 5. I tried a pair of feet descending.

Feb 4

We left at 7:10 & got to the ice at 7:40 & put on crampons at 8:20 & went off crampons at the head of Parnan & with the ice again at 8:50, were leaving the dark with the ice for safety. We got to the Prisms at 8:45-10. We walked & got the car going at 11 & worked the work at 12. Good luck & cleared up
