We had a bad fm - played with Hags. - slept. As my suitcase named something walked up wearing my shoes & hat. He saw me & put on a skull & then seeing ladies put on a skull. We left at 4 & got back at 7. And cleanies & I turned in camp.

Feb. 7 Thurs. I polished the top of my car with news paper, mended knuckles with my diary, & mended films.

Feb. 8 Fri. Walked up to Lake Umbagog with herin Ibarra & her niece & had lunch - back for tea. Talked of going up to the Kelley New camp then the news in taking off at the Fox had had an accident, as the car was rising about 20 feet of cables rushed across the line & the car was with the anchor carriage & the machine turned & crashed - Summersault. He escaped with a stiff leg & the two passengers got off by leg, the boy went off to the kitchen as he had a cut in the head. He returned about 11. One of my teeth was crumbling away & I decided to get it see a dentist in Hoka. Went down to the office during I received a translation of a news letter of Axel Edwards' death

2 or 3 times when biting something hard, it had seemed to give a very painful jolt.

Feb. 9 Sat. Soiled my teeth, with letters made arrangements for a Hoka Minnow & took dinner at Ross in the evening & he drove Joe Howard up as he had to visit the dentist also. John had an accident with the Grahams and Dodge very near with a bad Hercules. After dinner the ladies walked up to the glacier, as their names they got captured at the beach to Axel's Creek & turned back. One slipped & dislocated her shoulder, her friend got back & the friends went up to the car and got the book done

he took lunch with us & had it at the waiter little O. Benjamin

I stopped with the O. men & took evening at Ross 72 miles

Mon Feb. 11 left at 8:5 & was in Hoka at 5:45. I bought several things
& went to the bank at 9:30. He found a note in the bank & stopped it
temporarily. Joe and I out. I saw the chairman of the bank as he
he drove to Ross & saw the car at 6:00 am & left at 12.

He met Miss Paulin & her friend just before the Hoka. A
heavy thunderstorm came on about 9 am & continued
for some time. It was too hot to have tea as the tent
was not so good as the house & the wind was
strong. We got in at 5:20. Miss Roberts & herin Scott
of Danedin who were in the second school of La Penne
arrived. 112 mi

Feb. 12 Tues. We got away from the hotel at 11:50. Also Graham Jack Cox
Perry Haver & myself with the intention of going up to the valley
over the Bush & crossing the last bridge & staying the night
Camp Ochi had been under work about 500 feet on the side
of the Spruce. We crossed the first bridge at 12:10 & followed
quite a good track, having 2-2.25 before we slip descend
to the old camp below the little beach. We got to camp at
2. 45 - I had a bit of the bag & some food - also got "spook"
when getting the water. We then went down to the beach
& crossed the bridge & went up the Devil's staircase. I
was carrying practically nothing except my own things, but the
others had bags & heavy swags, & it was a blazing hot afternoon.
The Devil's staircase is very steep & was a creek for part of the
day while we were climbing it. We got to the top at 6:30 & went on
till 7:30 when we came to a small creek. We argued about camping
or going on to the point. Jack Cox had gone ahead to the point &
returned saying there was no water there, he returned & he decided at 7:30
to camp near the creek & about 100 ft above it in a fair spot.
