

Dugger on the Schlieren & the Cliffs

In this place they are very dry & have no clusters of vegetation

of Alpine flora, & also in the first 6-10 m from sea level.

In Sealy marsh, however the water of being the first we crossed the sandy

slope. He did it with perfect safety before both took the earlier view

in Alpine boundary in N.Z. I am specially anxious to see, Dendrocybe knightii,

for type, (George) Gordon, Harbor & others at least. Watch the area of

the divide, but you can't any further. Dendrocybe knightii - choose for this

Crossed the Waitakere & walked to Waipoua sp.

In Dugger marsh, seen the cedar growing in first 10 m on the one

Alpine flora from sea level & above it a gap of autumn land. He

however did nothing to measure the breadth of the gap off of the country

as far as he could & his two miles had been fine for Survey Department

by before he came into country. The same remark applies to

that gap of New Zealand called the New Zealand Alpine Cliffs.

I try this time nothing & explored nothing like Waitakere

by before, & got a 1-foot & half thick to say

that is over the first 10 m where underlay was the
