Oloto Panija (Continued)

Three pen drive for the Lands to Dan the Oloto the traveling is very good for Westland River

(p 39) Pan first ascended J. H. Miller & myself. (C.D) when traversing the Lands to Clark River. Then saw green after the Dardick came on for Lake Ohau & then the Pan down the Panija & the main S. Road. The scenery from the top of the Pan is magnificent. The whole Lands to Clark valley can be seen at once & the wonderful heat of the Hooker with glaciers & hanging ice & snow fields of white.

Douglas Spur.

This lake is about 15 mi. S of the Oloto Panija Pass. a slight depression difficult to see but a fine view of the Panija & a branch of the Clark. 15' around J. H. (C.D) is 1878. Road both up & down is easy. Splendid view from the Panija River & the Lands to Clark ^{this Hand Pan} about 5000 ft & easily free of snow for 5 months.

Muellers Pan.

In Oloto Panija Pan (the Hooker glacier). The Hooker range is high & covered with glaciers. Ascent from Lands to Clark difficult (! precipitous parts now) But ten feet into the Mueller's is precipitous & covered with hanging glaciers. Pan is wide U shaped depression. It was filled with the glacier in high cliffs, but high way along a break any one can climb. (p 41) height about 2000 ft. The saddle is grassed on the top & about 4000 ft - about the sea.
