

The death occurred on Friday the 11th of January 1946 at the Hornwall hospital of Mr James Watson at the age of 82. Born at Walkem Ck. B.C. in 1863 he spent his early years on his father's farm, later going to Australia where on June 9th 1890 he married Miss L. Graham of Fairbairn.

After their marriage Mr & Mrs Watson took up land in the Riverina district in N.S.W. where they remained for 16 years. Returning to N.Z. in 1906 Mrs Watson was engaged in farming in Taranaki & later in the Wairarapa. Later coming to Papakura where he lived in semi-retirement until he came to Glenbrook with his son in 1936.

Mrs Watson passed away in 1935 & his only daughter the late Mrs Bolton died six years later. He is survived by one son Mr L. L. Watson of Beachland.

During his life time he was a keen supporter of the Methodist church & was for a number of years Clerk of the Tuhitarama Road Board & Chairman of the school committee & Superintendent of the Sunday school in that district.
