The Minutes of last meeting were read and confirmed.
The Treasurer submitted the usual monthly report and
then made the following approximate of the account
owing by the Institute and the money in hand viz
Accounts due £76. 18. 0 Cash on hand £43. 1. 8
Postage £33. 16. 4

The Committee expressed their surprise at this state of
matters, and decided that the Clerk should devote
two days to canvassing the principal inhabitants of
the city for subscriptions including the members of
the Provincial and Town Councils.

the room may record their names they bring admitted
for for one month on doing so.
