# Laws

- 1<sup>st</sup> That this Institution shall be called, "The Christchurch Mechanics Institute."
- 2<sup>nd</sup> That the objects of this Institute be the mental improvement, and recreation of its Members by the establishment of a Library and Reading Rooms, the delivery of Lectures, and the formation of Discussion, Elementary, and other Classes.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> That the terms of Subscription to this Institute shall be one pound one shilling (£1. 1. 0) *per Annum* or seven shillings and six pence *per Quarter*, all subscriptions to be paid in advance.
- 4<sup>th</sup> That, the Government, of this Institute shall be vested in a managing Committee, consisting of the
