

16th That there shall be a business meeting of the members of the Institute in the last week of June, September, December and March of every year. The June meeting to be the Annual meeting of the Institute.

17th

That the Secretary shall at the request of twenty (20) members of the Institute call a special meeting of the members by advertisement in a local newspaper and by notices posted in the reading rooms. Such advertisements to state the object of the meeting and to give at least seven (7) days notice thereof.

18th All notices of motion shall be posted on the notice boards of the Institute seven (7) days prior to any Quarterly or Special meeting at which they are to

be submitted for consideration.

20th These Laws shall not be altered except by a majority of two thirds of the members present at an Annual meeting. Notice of such alteration to be given at the previous Quarterly Meeting.
