At a Special meeting of the Committee held March 15th 1867 it was

Resolved. That a Sub-committee be appointed to wait upon the Provincial Secretary to ascertain if the Provincial Government would enter into a negotiation with the Committee of the Institute for taking the Institute under the control of the Government on the basis that the Government pay the present liabilities of the Institute and establish a free Library, sub-committee to consist of Mr. Hawkes Mr. Preston, Mr. Hildup Mr. Farr and Mr. E. B. Bishop and to report at the next meeting of the Committee

That Mr. William Montgomery be requested to cooperate with the above Committee in carrying out the last resolution.

The Sub-committee appointed on the 15th March 1867 to wait on the Government for the purpose of ascertaining their views with respect to taking the Institute into their own hands and making it free to the Public on payment of the sum of £1000 to the Institute to pay off all claims of the Shareholders, beg to
