

VI.

That the Treasurer shall receive and pay all monies for and in behalf of this Institute; and shall have the general house-management, including the appointment and dismissal of the paid officers and servants of the Institute, subject to the approval of the Committee.

VII.

That except as hereinafter provided, the Treasurer shall pay into the Bank appointed by the Committee, to the credit of the Institute, all monies received by him, on its behalf, within forty-eight hours after he shall have received the same.

VIII

That the Treasurer may retain a balance not exceeding ten pounds for incidental expenses connected with the house-management.
