

Institute shall be open, and for the u maintenance of order and good conduct in the rooms of the society; and any member transgressing such rules shall be liable to a fine not exceeding two shillings and sixpence, subject to an appeal to the Committee.

Provided, always that such regulations shall be reported to the committee at its next sitting for confirmation or otherwise; and provided further, that no regulation once cancelled by the committee, shall be promulgated u again without its formal sanction.

XII.

That the Treasurer shall cause a suggestion book to be kept in the rooms of the Institute, in which any member may make such u suggestions as he may wish.
